Hebrews 13:16-25 (NASB) Teaching Notes

- 16 And do not neglect doing good and sharing, for with such sacrifices God is pleased.
- "neglect" (ἐπιλανθάνομαι) = no longer caring for
- ⇒ What other "sacrifices" please God?
- "doing good" (εὐποιῖα) = adoring good; beneficence
- "sharing" (κοινωνία) = commonness; joint participation; fellowship
- 17 **Obey** your leaders and **submit** to them, for they **keep watch** over your souls as those who will give an account. Let them do this with joy and not with **grief**, for this would be unprofitable for you.
- "obey" (πείθω) = to be persuaded so as to have trust, confidence
- "submit" (ὑπείκω) = to resist no longer, but to give way, yield (used of combatants)
- "keep watch" (ἀγρυπνέω) = chasing away sleep; attentive
- "grief" (στενάζω) = groaning
- Cf., Phil.2:16
- **18 Pray** for us, for we are sure that we have a good conscience, desiring to conduct ourselves honorably in all things.
- 19 And I urge *you* all the more to do this, so that I may be restored to you the sooner.
- 20 Now the God of peace, who brought up from the dead the great Shepherd of the sheep through the blood of the eternal covenant, *even* Jesus our Lord,
- **equip** you in every good thing to do His will, working in us that which is pleasing in His sight, through Jesus Christ, to whom *be* the glory forever and ever. Amen.
- "equip" (καταρτίζω) = to doctors, "to set a broken bone"; to fishermen, "to mend a broken net"; to sailors, "to outfit a ship for a voyage"; to soldiers, "to equip an army for battle."

- 22 But I urge you, brethren, bear with this word of exhortation, for I have written to you briefly.
- 23 Take notice that our brother Timothy has been released, with whom, if he comes soon, I will see you.

- 24 **Greet** all of your leaders and all the saints. Those from Italy greet you.
- 25 Grace be with you all.
