Jesus Christ Concealed in the OT ... Revealed in the NT

St. Augustine (354 – 430 AD), the Bishop of Hippo, wrote in his "Anti-Pelagian Writings" (Chapter 27 [XV]):

"Grace, concealed in the Old Testament, is revealed in the New ... This grace hid itself under a veil in the Old Testament, but it has been revealed in the New Testament according to the most perfectly ordered dispensation of the ages, forasmuch as God knew how to dispose all things ... it might be signified that it was then the time for concealing the grace, which had to be revealed in the New Testament by the death of Christ, -- the rending, as it were, of the veil."

The Gospel writer Luke records the unusual conversation that the resurrected Jesus had with two disciples on the road to Emmaus ... "Then beginning with Moses and with all the prophets, He explained to them the things concerning Himself in all the Scriptures" (24:27)
